

SO, you want to be a Drama Club Officer!!!



The Basic Requirements

1. All officers and representatives must be members of the International Thespian Society. (This doesn't include the Freshmen Rep.)
2. All officers and representatives are expected to attend all Drama Board Meetings and Drama Club Meetings.
 - ☆ Drama Club Meetings are usually once or twice a month on Tuesdays, after school.
 - ☆ The Drama Board meets weekly. (times are determined by board at the beginning of the year.)
3. All officers and representatives will be expected to uphold the duties of their office or face possible expulsion from that office.
4. **All officers and representatives will be expected to participate in Drama Club activities and in South High's Theatre Productions on and off-stage throughout the year.**



LEADERSHIP POSITIONS

President: Develops agendas for meetings, leads meetings, and oversees club activities.

Vice President: Organizes and emcees Awards Night, assists President with club activities.

Secretary/Treasurer: Posts minutes of meetings, takes attendance at meetings, sends notes to members, posts signs, takes money for dues, shirts, etc...

Activities Chairs: Assists in developing/planning drama club activities throughout the year as well as Community Service Projects. Recruits members to run & participate in activities.

Public Relations Chairs (Media/Marketing): Assists with promoting events and productions. Helps update social media and website. Posts information on callboard. Updates display areas.

Membership/Clerks: Promotes new members. Records and posts points from productions and activities.

Historians: Develops the yearly scrapbook and helps with the troupe display for State Conference and for productions.

*****All officers can assist with any office, committee, project, activity!*

Class Representatives: work with the officers on production needs, developing club activities and organizing community service projects. (We elect these positions in the fall.)
