Itinerary –

Thursday, May 2 –

2:15 – Brief rehearsal on stage. Any cast members available, please pass to the theatre for rehearsal.

Sunday, May 5 –

9:45 am – meet at South High to gather costumes and load bus.

10:00 am – bus departs for Century II

11:30 am – arrive at Century II (we will take costumes inside to leave in the dressing room)

11:45-12:45 – Santiago has rehearsal for the Leading Roles Medley

12:45-1:30 – We rehearse our group number and Santiago's medley

(Even if you are wearing your 'red carpet' attire all day – be sure you are comfortable enough for the rehearsal and if needed wear your costume shoes for the rehearsal.)

1:30 – load bus to depart Century II

--- During this break we will go somewhere for a meal, possibly to Towne East. Students who need to change for red carpet will need to do so during this meal break.

2:45 – return to Century II

3:00-4:00 – the time for the Red Carpet / entrance / finding seats

4:00 pm – Jester Awards ceremony

The awards are held at Century II Performing Arts Center in Wichita. General admission seating.
